The goal of this work is to present a surgical technique to put blade implants into lower jaw with partial or total absence of alveolar bone above the mandibular canal. Within this technique we can safety localize the canal, detect the thickness of the disposable bone bilaterally of it and insert the implant until the basilar if it is necessary. After eigth years use of this techni que the authors have comproved its advantages.
